Dear Friends,

Wednesday last was the **Feast of St Patrick** and Mass was celebrated at Carmel College for a Pastoral Care class from Avila House. These students range from Yr 7 to Yr 12 from around 12 to 19 years old. St Patrick although raised by religious parents wasn't strongly religious himself at a young age. When he was 16 was kidnapped by pirates and sold into slavery in Ireland. He was thought to have been born in Brittain, probably Wales. As a slave in Ireland he was charged with looking after the sheep, and it was on the

lonely Irish hillsides that his deep religious commitment grew and flourished. He said in his 'Confessions', "Every day I had to tend sheep, and many times a day I prayed... I used to get up for prayer before daylight, through snow, through rain, and I felt no harm, and there was no sloth in me – as I now see, because the spirit within me was fervent." After about 7 years as a slave, he escaped and fled to France where he became a disciple of St Germain of Auxerre, spending the next 15 years at Auxerre preparing for his priestly ordination. Patrick had a dream to return to Ireland as a missionary and Pope Celestine had sent Palladius as the first missionary in about 430 but he died there within a year. Patrick was then ordained a Bishop by St Germain and sent to take up the work started by Palladius. He initially experienced violent opposition from the Druids and warring kings, but succeeded in converting some of the indigenous chieftans and was very skillful and successful in adapting the Gospel to the Irish culture. In thirty years of labour, mostly in the west and north, Patrick and his coworkers converted Ireland. It is believed that Patrick died on March 17, 461 and was buried at Saul on Strangford Lough, where he had built his first church.

As Patrick related in his 'Confessions', it was as a young 16 year old as a slave on the lonely hillsides tending sheep, that he found God or rather God found him.

These Carmel students, many around the age of Patrick, listened to his story and it was an opportunity to pray for all young people that they, like Patrick, will find quiet times where God can come into their lives and set their hearts on fire.

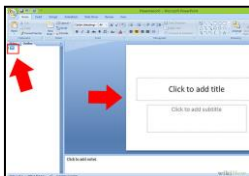


Fifth Sunday of Lent

POWER POINT PRESENTATIONS VOLUNTEER NEEDED:

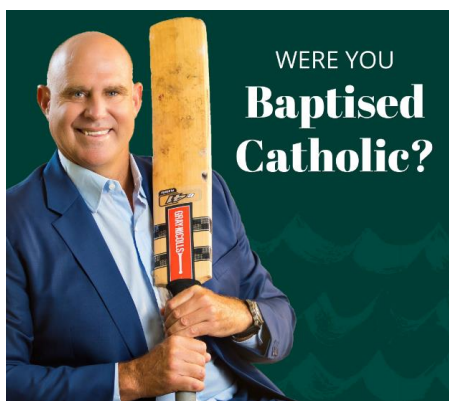
