Dear friends in Jesus Christ,

We were in the "Family Week" from 22nd to 26th June, to celebrate the "World Meeting of Families." The World Meeting of Families, created by Saint Pope John Paul II in 1994, has been celebrated every three years in a variety of

host countries around the world. The theme for this year is "family Love: a vocation and a path to Holiness."

On this occasion of World Meeting of Families, I like to quote two numbers from **Catechism of Catholic Church about family. Firstly, number 2204**, which says, "the Christian family constitutes a specific revelation and realization of ecclesial communion, and for this reason it can and should be called a Domestic Church. "It is a community of faith, hope, and charity; it assumes singular importance in the Church, as is evident in the New Testament."

Before God created Church or Government, He created the family to partake in creation. The families are the backbone of the Church. Pope Francis said: "We need spouses alongside the pastors, to walk with other families, to help those who are weaker, to announce that, even in difficulties, Christ is present in the Sacrament of Marriage to give tenderness, patience and hope to all, in every situation of life". Our being family - spouses, daughters and sons, grandchildren, grandmothers and grandfathers, sisters and brothers - is in fact a resource for our Church communities. Having learned to love one another - in the school that has been our families - helps us to share our love with those around us and to be witnesses to those who struggle the most.

**Secondly, CCC number 2205.** "The Christian family is a communion of persons, a sign and image of the communion of the Father and the Son in the Holy Spirit. In the procreation and education of children, it reflects the Father's work of creation. It is called to partake of the prayer and sacrifice of Christ. Daily prayer and the reading of the Word of God strengthen it in charity. The Christian family has an evangelizing and missionary task.

Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI said, "the human family is, in a certain sense, the icon of the Trinity because of the love between its members and the fruitfulness of that love." Families need to pray and worship together to learn how to love one another with the love that comes from God's own heart. Families that pray and participate in the sacraments together are actively learning to love at the feet of the Master. Praying individually makes us God's children. Praying together makes us God's family, a domestic church.

I strongly believe that the family is the powerhouse of all vocations. Family love is a vocation, which can produce a call to many vocations. Family is a path to holiness, which needs love, care, sacrifice, understanding and above all the presence of Trinitarian God. The family of Joseph and Mary had all the reasons to be a broken family. However, they formed it into Holy Family. What made the difference is the presence of Jesus and their willingness to listen to God. Dear friends, let us listen to God and bring Jesus into our families, so that we can also make our ordinary families into a Holy Family.

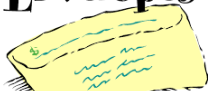
