Dear Friends,
This Sunday, which we have traditionally called Palm Sunday, has a new name. It is now officially called 'Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord.' Living in such changing times we are probably beyond being surprised about anything but this new name, even though quite a mouthful does a reasonable job. At the main Mass on this Sunday, Palms are usually blessed on the oval in front of the school and a procession with palms then proceeds into the Church to the tune of a triumphal hymn, like 'The King of Glory'. During the blessing of palms the Gospel of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem is read. Once inside the church the joyful welcome of Jesus into Jerusalem is soon left behind as the Gospel reading is the Passion. This year we listen to the Passion story according to Mark. For quite some years now this 'Palm Sunday' could also be called 'Passion Sunday' although most of us stuck to 'Palm Sunday'. A movement to the new official title 'Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord' sounds like a fair description of what the liturgy of this day is all about.

A long time ago in a Parish far from here, a creative liturgy group wrestled with the 'Liturgy of 'Palm Sunday' and suggested that the reading of the 'Passion' be left out altogether and only read the Gospel of the Entry into Jerusalem. Then the focus would really be on 'Palm Sunday'. However, the rather mixture of moods from the 'Entry into Jerusalem' in triumph and the reading of the Passion in this Sunday's Liturgy, gives an overture of the three great days of Holy Week: Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.

So the lengthy title: Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord gives a good description of what the Liturgy of this Sunday is all about. As important and as traditional as the 'palms' are, this Sunday goes beyond the joyous welcome which quickly turned from the 'Hosannas' into the strident call 'Crucify him'.

'Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord' gives us an overview of this coming week and invites us to walk with Jesus from the wonderful welcome into Jerusalem, through the Last Supper (Holy Thursday) the Passion and death of Jesus on the cross (Good Friday) to the glorious Resurrection. These three days are called the 'Triduum', meaning three days, and

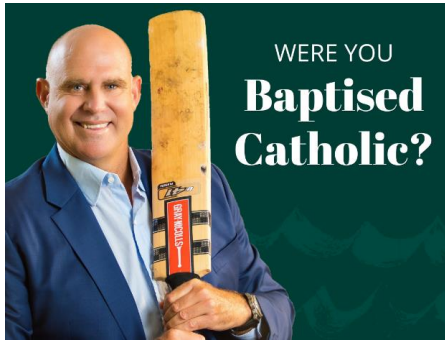


Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord 28 March 2021
