The Second Sunday of Easter is celebrated as Divine Mercy Sunday. The readings for this Sunday show our need for God's Divine Mercy, which is offered to us through the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the forgiveness of our sins, and through each celebration of the Sacraments when we receive them in faith.

The first reading explains how the early Church grew daily because of acts of mercy, such as engaging in sacrificial agape love. In the second reading, St. Peter glorifies God, showing His mercy in granting His Son, Jesus resurrection from the dead and glorious ascension into Heaven, thus assuring our resurrection. Today's Gospel intensely reminds us of how Jesus instituted the Sacrament of Reconciliation, a sacrament of Divine Mercy. The risen Lord gave his Apostles the power to forgive sins with the words, "Whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain, they are retained" (Jn 20:19-23). Presenting the doubting Thomas' famous profession of Faith, "My Lord and my God," the Gospel illustrates how Jesus showed mercy to the doubting apostle and emphasized the importance of Faith for everyone. Today let us pray to our God for His never-ending mercy and also prepare ourselves to forgive others.
